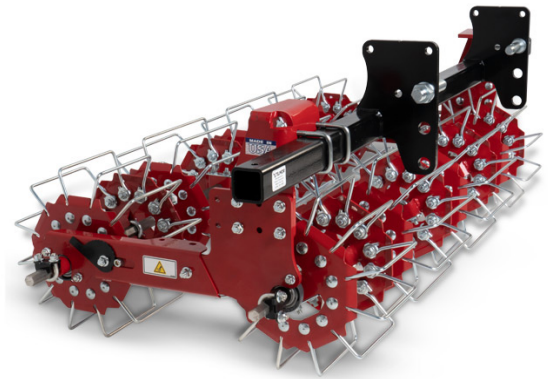
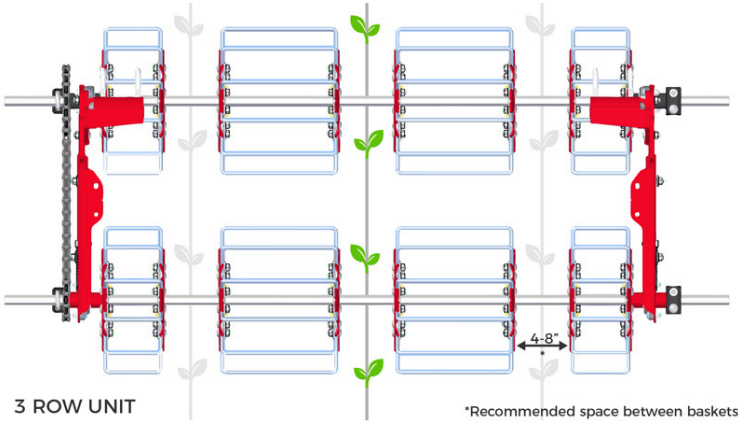




The Tilmor Basket Weeder is typically used for interrow weeding. The wire baskets are spaced apart to allow for the crop row to pass between. Basket weeders may also be used to prepare a stale seedbed by placing the baskets together and running over the entire width of a seedbed.



BASKET WEEDER OPTIONS

BED/CULTIVATION WIDTH

- 60" Axle for max of 53" cultivation width
- 80" Axle for max of 73" cultivation width

ROW SPACING

- Min. of 6"
- Baskets can be put together for spacing larger than 15"

BASKET SIZE

- 3" to 12" available
- 1.5" to 2" space on either side of crop recommended

STALEBEDDING

- Place baskets together to cover bed width
- A mid-mount kit can be added on the basket weeder frame to allow the use of A-blades for stalebedding and for cultivating different row spacings.
